Beginner 1	· Korean alphabet, pronunciation, basic vocabulary and grammar · Basic phrases needed for various informal and personal situations (such conversations with family or other routine situations)
Beginner 2	· Various grammar elements including auxiliary verbs as well as causative and passive verbs; idioms, abstract and everyday expressions · Korean cultural aspects such as legends, myths, holidays, etc.
Intermediate 1	· Korean society (economy, politics, etc.) and business language and knowledge · Formal expressions for various situations
Intermediate 2	· Natural communication and the understanding of the Korean way of thinking through idiomatic expressions, proverbs, etc. · Understanding the full range of Korean culture (culture, sports, entertainment, and etc.)
Advanced 1	· Forming new sentences through the understanding of various changes in vocabulary and speech. · Understanding the news articles and preparation for graduate and undergraduate courses
Advanced 2	· Practice discussions and debates, and improve vocabulary through the practice of using unique expressions. · Practice professional research of various topics and the writing of reports.

* Domestic applicants or applicants who do not require a visa can apply for admission two weeks before the class starts.

* All classes will be delivered in Korean (original language).

* There will be no classes on the first day of the semester, and course orientation will be conducted online. Offline classes will begin on the second day

03 Payment and Refund

1 Fee

- * Applicants who want to acquire D-4 visa must apply at least two semesters.
- * Please contact the office beforehand, since the applicable semester may vary based on nationality or type of visa.
 - Apply for two semesters: The United States, East Asia, China, France and Australia
 - Apply for four semesters: Russia, Southeast Asia, and Central Asia
- * Screening fee must be paid together with the application
- * Textbook fee (50,000 KRW) to be paid separately (more information will be available after admission).

2 Payment Method

- Remit the tuition fee with the applicant’s name or passport number (Invoice and information package will be delivered after the screening)
- * Applicants will be responsible for exchange rate fee charges. (Applicants will pay the difference after admissions).

3 Refunds

- * An applicant who wants to withdraw the enrollment must submit the refund request form to Language Education Center.
- * Fees will be refunded under the conditions listed below. The dormitory fee will be prorated according to admissions date, and other miscellaneous charges will not be refunded
- * The Immigration Center will be notified about applicants who cancel admissions after obtaining their visa, and their visa will be automatically canceled.

- * Required Documents: Refund request form, a copy of bankbook, a certificate of admission (if visa has not yet been obtained)
- * Further process will be under the rules and regulations of Language Education Center.

04 Application procedure

1 Qualifications

- Completion of high school education or its equivalent.
- ※ Vietnam: Applications from the Ha Tinh and Nghe An regions are not accepted. For vocational schools, applicants with a minimum score of 80 are eligible to apply

2 Required Documents

- All documents must be submitted in original form in person to the Office of International Affairs upon entry to Korea after final acceptance
- A. Common Documents (Required for both visa holders and non-holders)

A copy of passport and alien registration card	Alien registration card is required only for visa holders

Screening fee 50,000KRW	Non-refundable

- B. Additional Documents (required for those who live overseas)
- 1) Study plan
 - 2) Bank statement (verifying a balance of over 8,000,000 KRW)
 - 3) A certificate of parent’s employment and income(at least USD 8,000 per year)
 - 4) Certificate of family relationship
 - 5) A copy of citizenship certificates of parents and applicants (verifying foreign nationality)
 - 6) School transcript (Written in Korean or English, Apostille or Korean Embassy certified)
- * All documents must be written in Korean or English. Documents in any other languages must have a notarized translation attached.
 - * Additional documents may be requested.
 - * As required documents may vary depending on the country of origin and visa type, prior inquiry is required

05 Visa information

1 D-4 (Language Course student visa)

- A. Applicants: a student who wants to enroll for a period of 6 months or longer
- B. Where to Apply: Overseas Korean embassy or consulate office
- C. Required Documents
- Visa issuance application, a copy of passport, photo, visa issuance fee
 - School documents (school will send documents after a student transfers the tuition fee): Admission letter by Dong-A University, a confirmation letter of tuition fee, etc.
 - A graduation certificate of the most recently attended school
 - Proof of Financial Capability (at least USD 8,000 per year): Parents' proof of income and certificate of employment
 - Certificate of Bank Balance (at least KRW 8,000,000)
 - TB Test Certificate

Family Relations Proof Sample
China : 户口本 or 亲属关系证明 notarization, Philippines: Family Census, Indonesia : KARTU KELUARGA, Vietnam : So Ho Khau or Giay Khai Sinh, Pakistan : Family Certificate

※ These are the basic requirements for applying for the visa. Conditions may vary depending on the country, so please check with the Korean embassies in your country before applying for the visa.

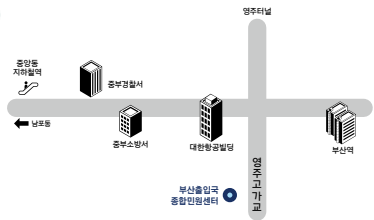
- * The dormitory fee must be paid to the dormitory account at the time of receiving the invoice after entering Korea (Monthly payments are not accepted.)
- * Meals are excluded.
- * Students shall prepare their own beddings in advance since it will not be provided by the dormitory (rentals for beddings are available).
- * No Wi-Fi connection will be available in the dormitory. Students shall either use the LAN cable provided by the dormitory or prepare their own Wi-Fi router.
- * Newcomers must stay in the dormitory at least 3 months. The course will be terminated if you leave the dormitory within 3 months.
- * Refrigerated/frozen foods cannot be stored(Please do not bring)
- * After final acceptance, students must arrive in Korea, complete the dormitory application form, and pay the dormitory fee

07 Insurance

- 1 **Subject** all students intending to stay in Korea for more than 90 days after entry
- 2 **Type** National Medical Insurance, Private international Student insurance, or other international medical insurance which are applicable in Korea
- 3 **Cost** Around 70,000 KRW (for group private insurance)
- 4 **Payment** Students applying for the group private insurance can make payments after entering Korea.
Students who are enrolled with an insurance from their own country should provide proof of insurance after entering Korea.
* Effective starting from March of 2015, all international students are required to have insurances according to the laws of the Korean government.
* From February 2021, foreigners staying in Korea for more than 6 months are obligated to subscribe to public health insurance and pay insurance premiums. Please note that the exact premium and subscription details will be provided after entering our university.

- A. Duties: Issuing alien registration card, extension of length of stay, change in types of visa, change in address, reports and declarations and etc.
